



## COVID- 19 CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

As we reopen our doors and commence our Sunday Services and mid-week meetings again, the safety of our staff, congregants and visitors is of paramount importance. We have put the following measures in place to prioritise the health and well-being of everyone.

Staff, congregants and visitors; including trades services are not permitted to enter our premises if they:

- are experiencing the following symptoms, presenting unwell: unexplained or persistent cough, drowsy or unresponsive, shortness of breath, respiratory illness, runny nose, sore throat, fever, diarrhea, vomiting or persistent headaches;
- have been in close contact with a person who has tested positive for COVID-19 (during the period of time in which the virus is contagious);
- are awaiting the results of a test for COVID-19;
- reside with anyone who is awaiting the results of a test for COVID-19;
- have returned from international travel and failed to observe the government requirement to quarantine for 14 days.

Staff, congregants and visitors; including trade services who are not subject to any of the above conditions for exclusion must be willing and able to agree to the following requirements:

- mandatory temperature checks for children 2-12 years of age upon arrival and acknowledge that One Life Church also reserve the right to temperature check adults at their discretion. Temperatures 37.5°C or greater is considered unwell and will need to leave the premises immediately.
- to leave the premises immediately if they become unwell, after notifying a Sunday Service Team Member;
- to at all times, maintain social distancing measures (as per the NSW Health guidelines) with respect to other staff, congregants and visitors;
- to maintain good personal hand hygiene by washing their hands regularly and thoroughly and/or using hand sanitiser provided;
- to maintain good respiratory hygiene by coughing or sneezing into their elbow or a tissue, and then disposing of tissues immediately;
- to provide One Life Church Mudgee (Christian Outreach Centre Mudgee) with their name and contact details and consent to One Life Church Mudgee (Christian Outreach Centre Mudgee) providing their name and contact details to the NSW Department of Health or any other third-party government department, as required to enable contact tracing procedures;
- to acknowledge that they may be asked to wait, or be refused entry, to One Life Church Mudgee (Christian Outreach Centre Mudgee) premises in the event that the premises have reached its total capacity under NSW Health social distancing requirements;
- to acknowledge the right of One Life Church Mudgee (Christian Outreach Centre Mudgee) to refuse entry or request their departure from our sites at any time and for any reason;
- to at all times, treat staff, team members and other congregants and visitors with respect.
